1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1 This privacy policy is for information purposes only, which means that it is not a source of obligations for users of the website, including the Maritex Online Store. The document concerns the Maritex website (www.maritex.eu).

1.2 All words, expressions, and acronyms appearing in this document and beginning with a capital letter (e.g., Seller, Online Store, Electronic Service) should be understood in accordance with their definitions contained in the Terms and Conditions of the Online Store available on the Maritex Online Store website at www.maritex.eu.

2. GDPR, PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF DATA COLLECTION AND DATA RECIPIENTS

2.1 The purpose of this notice is to provide you with information regarding the processing of your personal data by "MARITEX" Leszek Łosin Sp. j., based in Gdynia (81-577), ul. Rdestowa 53D, phone +48 58 622 89 00, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court Gdańsk – Północ in Gdańsk, 8th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS number: 0000880720, NIP: 9581659572; REGON 221578676 – acting, within the scope described below, as the controller of your personal data (hereinafter the "Controller", "MARITEX") in a simple, concise and transparent manner. The set of information provided herein complies with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, "GDPR").

2.2 To guarantee full protection of your data, as well as free access to necessary information about processing and your rights, MARITEX provides you with an email address where you can contact the Controller if you have any questions or doubts concerning personal data protection: rodo@maritex.eu.

2.3 This notice is for information purposes only and does not require any action on your part.

3. PURPOSES, SCOPE AND LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING YOUR PERSONAL DATA

3.1 MARITEX processes the personal data collected from you primarily to perform the contract binding you with MARITEX, e.g., a Sales Agreement, to provide services to you, e.g., Electronic Services such as creating an Account in the Online Store, or to take steps necessary to conclude a contract or to commence the provision of services (based on Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR).

3.2 Additionally, MARITEX may also process your personal data in order to fulfill legal obligations imposed on it as the Controller (Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR). Sometimes MARITEX processes your data for purposes based on the Controller's legitimate interests (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR), e.g., direct marketing of our services, pursuing claims against you, defending against claims, conducting court proceedings, ensuring network and information security. In other cases, the basis for processing is your consent (Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR), e.g., to receive requested commercial information or a Newsletter.

3.3 Providing your personal data is voluntary but necessary for proper performance of the contract or provision of services. MARITEX processes the personal data collected from you only to the extent necessary to achieve the purposes listed herein.

3.4 If consent to data processing is given, such consent may be withdrawn by you at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

4. RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA

In the course of normal business operations, MARITEX may transfer your personal data to external recipients (while meeting all requirements ensuring their security arising from data protection regulations), when this proves necessary in business processes, in ensuring high quality of services, as well as in fulfilling MARITEX's legal obligations. The above includes the following categories of data recipients:

4.1 service providers supplying MARITEX with technical and organizational solutions enabling efficient functioning and management of MARITEX (in particular IT service providers, courier and postal companies);

4.2 providers of legal, advisory, consulting, auditing, tax, accounting services, and those supporting MARITEX in pursuing due claims (in particular law firms, debt collection companies).

5. DURATION OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

Your data are processed for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this notice, including the duration of the contract binding you with MARITEX or the provision of services to you, and after its expiration/termination for the period required by law (e.g., tax regulations) or necessary to pursue the Controller's legitimate interests (e.g., pursuing claims), whereas in the case of consent to data processing – until it is withdrawn.

6. DATA TRANSFER OUTSIDE THE EEA OR TO INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS, PROFILING

Your data will not be transferred to entities based outside the European Economic Area and will not be subject to profiling.

7. YOUR RIGHTS

In connection with the protection of your personal data, you have a number of rights under the GDPR. These include the following rights.

7.1 The right to rectify data if it turns out that the processed data are incorrect.

7.2 The right to access your data, including to obtain a copy thereof and information on processing.

7.3 The right to request the deletion of personal data in cases specified by the GDPR.

7.4 The right to request restriction of processing.

7.5 The right to data portability which you provided to MARITEX.

7.6 The right to object to processing due to your particular situation or where personal data are processed in the Controller's legitimate interest.

7.7 The right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority (President of the Personal Data Protection Office) if you consider that the processing of your personal data by MARITEX violates the law.

If you exercise any of your rights, MARITEX will make every effort and take the necessary steps to fulfil them.

8. COOKIES

8.1 Cookies are small text information in the form of text files sent by a server and stored on the side of a person visiting this website (e.g., on a computer hard drive, laptop, or on a smartphone memory card – depending on the device used by the visitor). Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, the time they are stored on the end

8.2 Cookies are necessary for proper use of the Maritex website, including the Online Store, and are used, among other things, to identify the User, remember data entered in the Order Forms, the Cart, monitor and maintain login status, remember privacy preferences, as well as remember data from other online forms or surveys. They are also used to compile statistics showing how the Online Store website is used and for marketing purposes.

8.3 MARITEX may process data contained in cookies while visitors use the website and the Online Store. Cookies placed on the user's end device may also be used by entities cooperating with the Controller outside the European Economic Area, in particular companies: Google and Facebook.

8.4 We use the following types of cookies.

8.4.1 Necessary cookies – ensure the proper functioning of our website and its basic functions; they do not enable identification of a specific user. Without them, proper use of our website and the Online Store will not be possible; therefore they cannot be disabled.

8.4.2 Analytical and performance cookies – used for internal purposes and allow tracking of movements on our website and in the Online Store. Refusal to store these cookies is possible and will not limit the functionality of the website and the Online Store.

8.4.3 Advertising cookies – used to collect information and display personalized content and ads on our website and in the Online Store. Refusal to store these cookies is possible and will not limit the functionality of the website and the Online Store.

8.5 Adjusting the scope of cookies stored by our website on the user's device is possible via the cookie preferences panel available on our website or via browser settings. In this way, it is possible to change cookie preferences, including withdrawing consent given.

8.6 During your visit to our website, a banner will be displayed informing you that it uses cookies, allowing you to adjust cookie preferences.

9. FINAL PROVISIONS

9.1 The website and the Online Store may contain links to other websites. The Controller encourages you, after moving to other websites, to read the privacy policy established there. This privacy policy applies only to this website.

9.2 The Controller applies technical and organizational measures ensuring protection of processed personal data appropriate to the risks and categories of data being protected, in particular protecting data against disclosure to unauthorized persons, being taken by an unauthorized person, processing in violation of applicable regulations, and change, loss, damage, or destruction.

9.3 The Controller provides the following technical measures to prevent unauthorized acquisition and modification of personal data transmitted electronically:

9.3.1 securing the data set against unauthorized access, including an SSL certificate.

9.3.2 access to the Account only after providing an individual login and password.
